Guadalupe Corona - Harp

Mexico City native, Guadalupe Corona is a graduate of the National Conservatory of Music & the Victoria Conservatory of Music. She's been principal harpist of the Symphony Orchestra of the Autonomous University of the State of Hidalgo, San Luis Potosi Symphony Orchestra & Jalisco Philharmonic Orchestra. In 1996, she participated in the 6th World Harp Congress in Seattle/Tacoma & in 2017 in the 13th World Harp Congress in Hong Kong. A four-time grant recipient from the Mexican National Fund for Culture & Arts. Her projects include publishing the complete harp works by Mario Ruiz Armengol. Her teaching includes the National Conservatory of Music in Mexico. Parallel to her work as harpist, she has developed in the field of

audiovisual production about the investigation, rescue, & dissemination of Mexico's musical heritage.

Eva Rodrígues - Flute

Graduated in Orchestral Instrumentalist, specializing in Baroque flute, from the Academia Nacional Superior de Orquestra de Lisboa, Portugal, with specialization in Pedagogy, from the University of Madeira. Her initial training was at the Conservatory of Music of Porto and at the Escola Superior de Música e Artes de Espetáculo do Porto specializing in Early Music. She has taught Baroque Flute at the Metropolitan Conservatory of Lisbon, Conservatory of Music & Professional School of Arts of Madeira, Conservatory of Music of Emil Friedman College, in Caracas, and at the System of Orchestras & Youth & Children & Choirs of Venezuela. She won second place in The International Competition of Young Performers, held in Funchal, Portugal, in 2004. She is currently a flutist with the Zapopan Chamber Orchestra.


